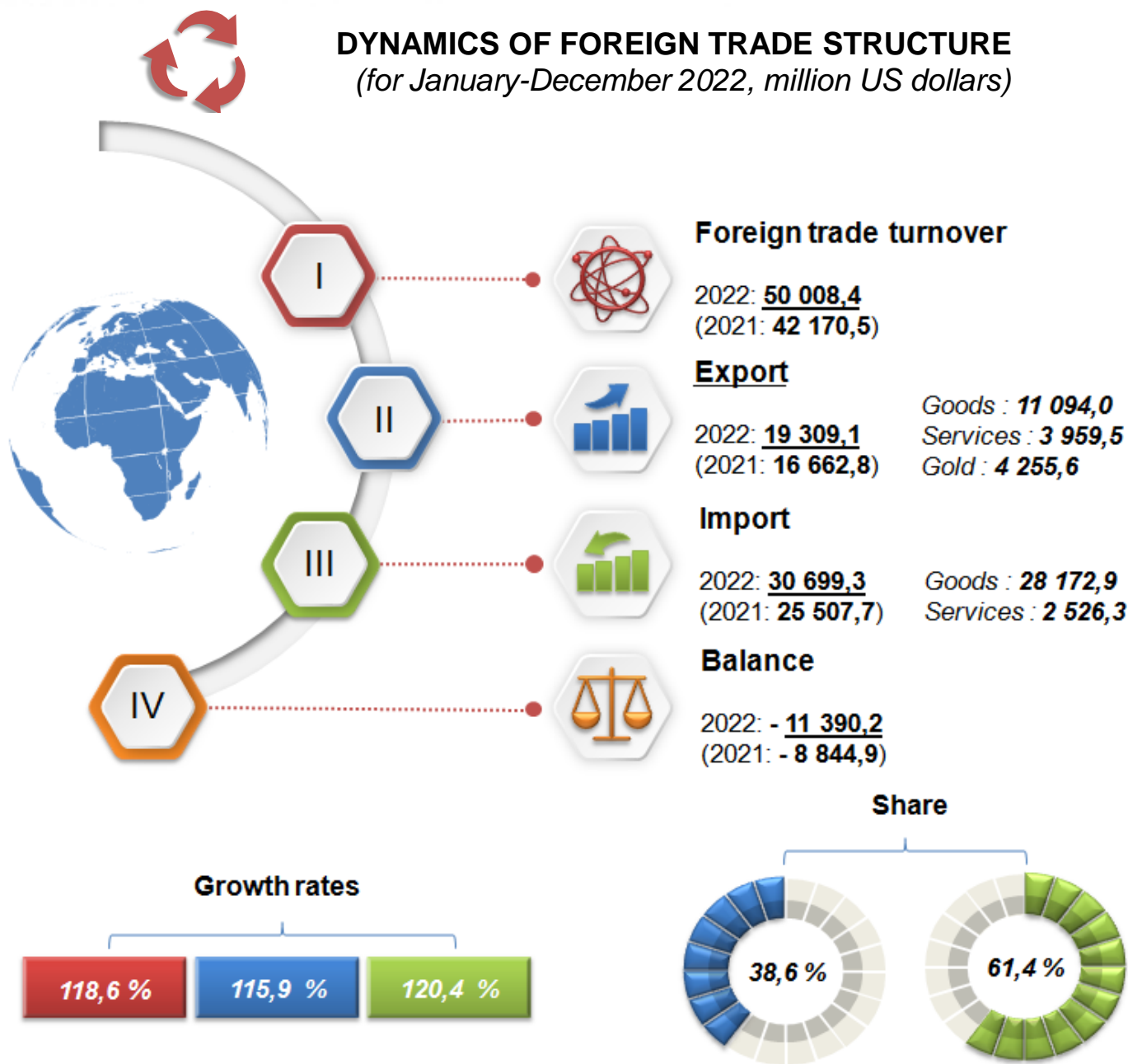


# Foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan

## DYNAMICS OF FOREIGN TRADE STRUCTURE

(for January-December 2022, million US dollars)



According to the results of January-December 2022, the foreign trade turnover of the republic reached **50 008,4** million US dollars, which, compared to the same period in 2021, increased by **7 837,9** million US dollars (an increase of **18,6 %**).

For reference: when forming statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the United Nations International Standard Trade Classification (**hereinafter - SITC**) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods. The assignment of **SITC** codes to goods is carried out using transitional keys between the **HS** and **SITC**.













Of the total volume of the FTT, exports amounted to **19 309,1** million US dollars (by January-December 2021, an increase of **15,9** %), and imports – **30 699,3** million US dollars (an increase of **20,4** %).

As a result, the balance of foreign trade turnover amounted to a passive balance in the amount of **-11 390,2** million US dollars.



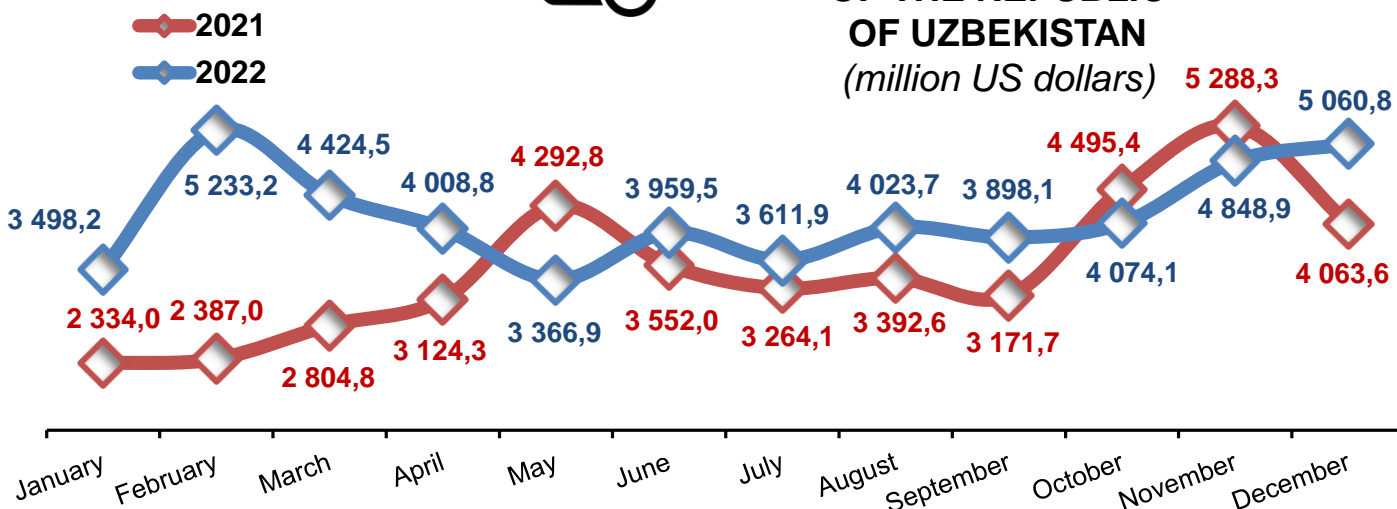

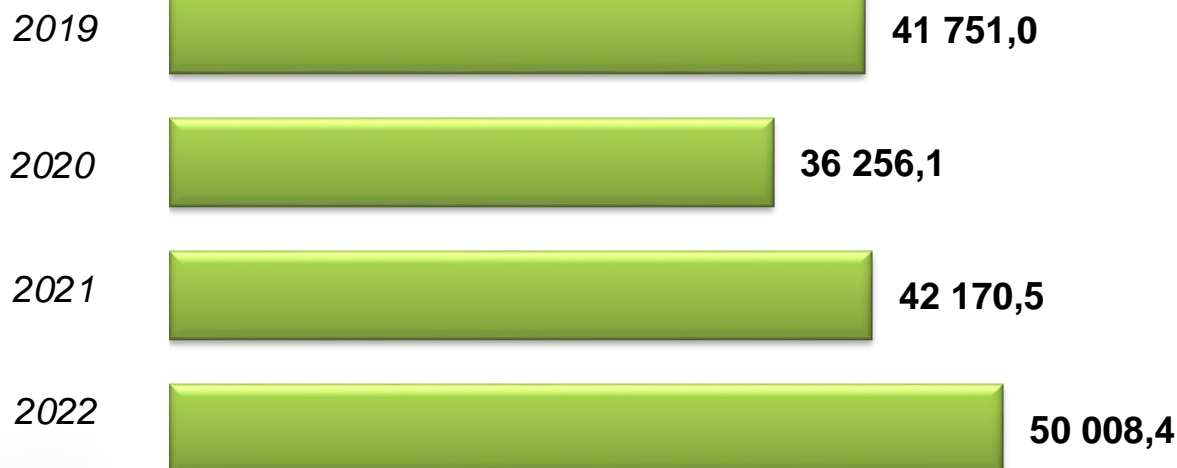


## MONTHLY DYNAMICS OF FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (million US dollars)



The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded in February 2022 and was noted at the level of **5 233.2** million US dollars. Compared to the same month in 2021, its increase was **2 846.2** million US dollars. In December 2022, the volume of foreign trade turnover amounted to **5 060.8** million US dollars and, compared to the same period in 2021, it decreased by **24.5%**.

### DYNAMICS OF INDICATORS OF FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER (for January-December, million US dollars)



The foreign trade turnover of Uzbekistan in January-December 2022 amounted to **50 008.4** million US dollars, which is **19.8%** more than in the same period of 2019.



Among the 20 major partner countries in foreign economic activity, there is an active foreign trade balance with three countries, in particular with such countries as Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan. A passive balance of foreign trade turnover is maintained with 17 countries.

To date, the Republic of Uzbekistan has trade relations with **204** countries of the world. The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with the Russian Federation (**18.6%**), China (**17.8%**), Kazakhstan (**9.2%**), Turkiye (**6.4%**), the Republic of Korea (**4.7%**), Kyrgyzstan (**2.5%**) and Germany (**2.3%**).

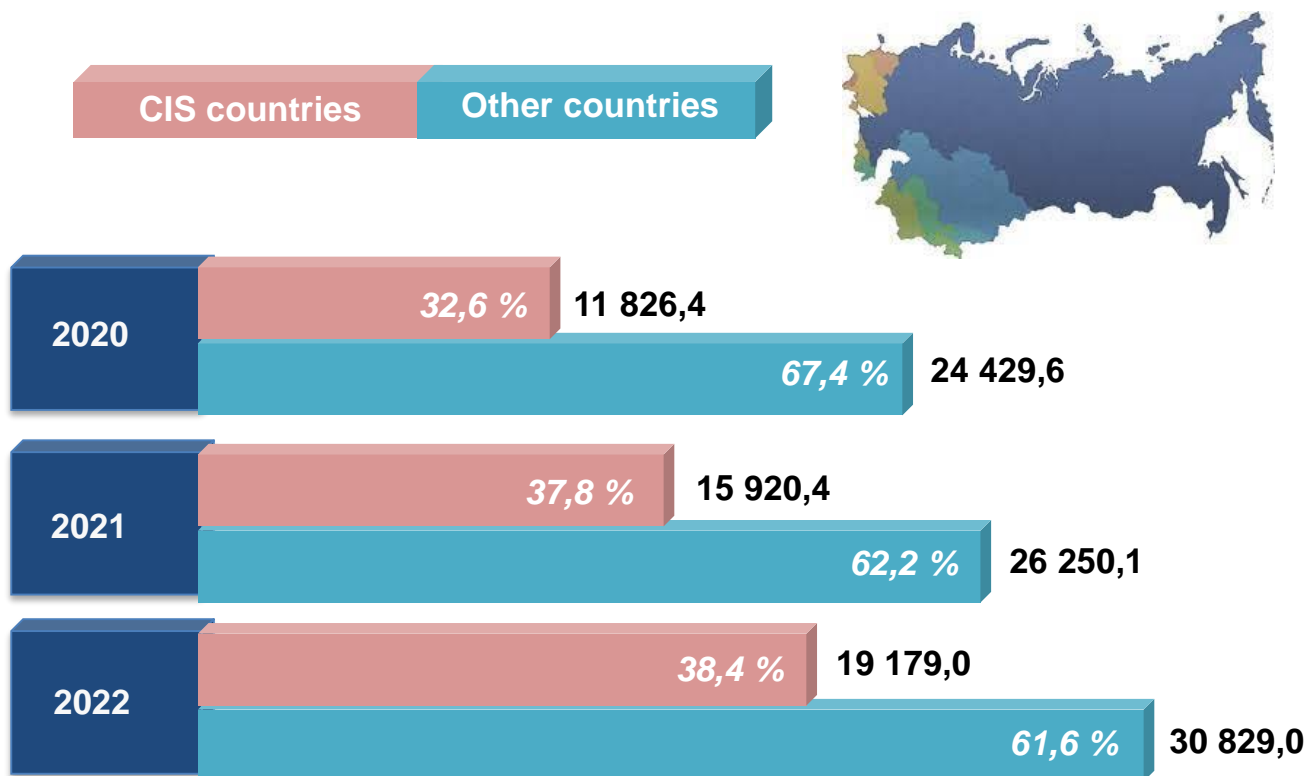
In the structure of foreign trade turnover of the republic, a significant share was noted in Tashkent city, which is **39.1%**, or **19 530.1** million US dollars, and the smallest share was recorded at **0.7%**, or **372.8** million US dollars, which is noted in Surkhandarya region.

## DYNAMICS OF THE VOLUME OF THE CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN STATES IN THE FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

The share of foreign trade turnover of the CIS countries in the period under review, compared to the same period in 2021, increased by **0.6%** and their share in foreign trade turnover, in January-December 2022, amounted to **38.4%**.



The volume of foreign trade turnover of other states in January-December 2022, compared to the same period in 2021, respectively, decreased by **0.6%** and amounted to **61.6%** of the total foreign trade turnover.

The foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the CIS countries reached **19 179.0** million US dollars. Of these, the volume of exports amounted to **7 855.2** million US dollars, and the volume of imports – **11 323.8** million US dollars.

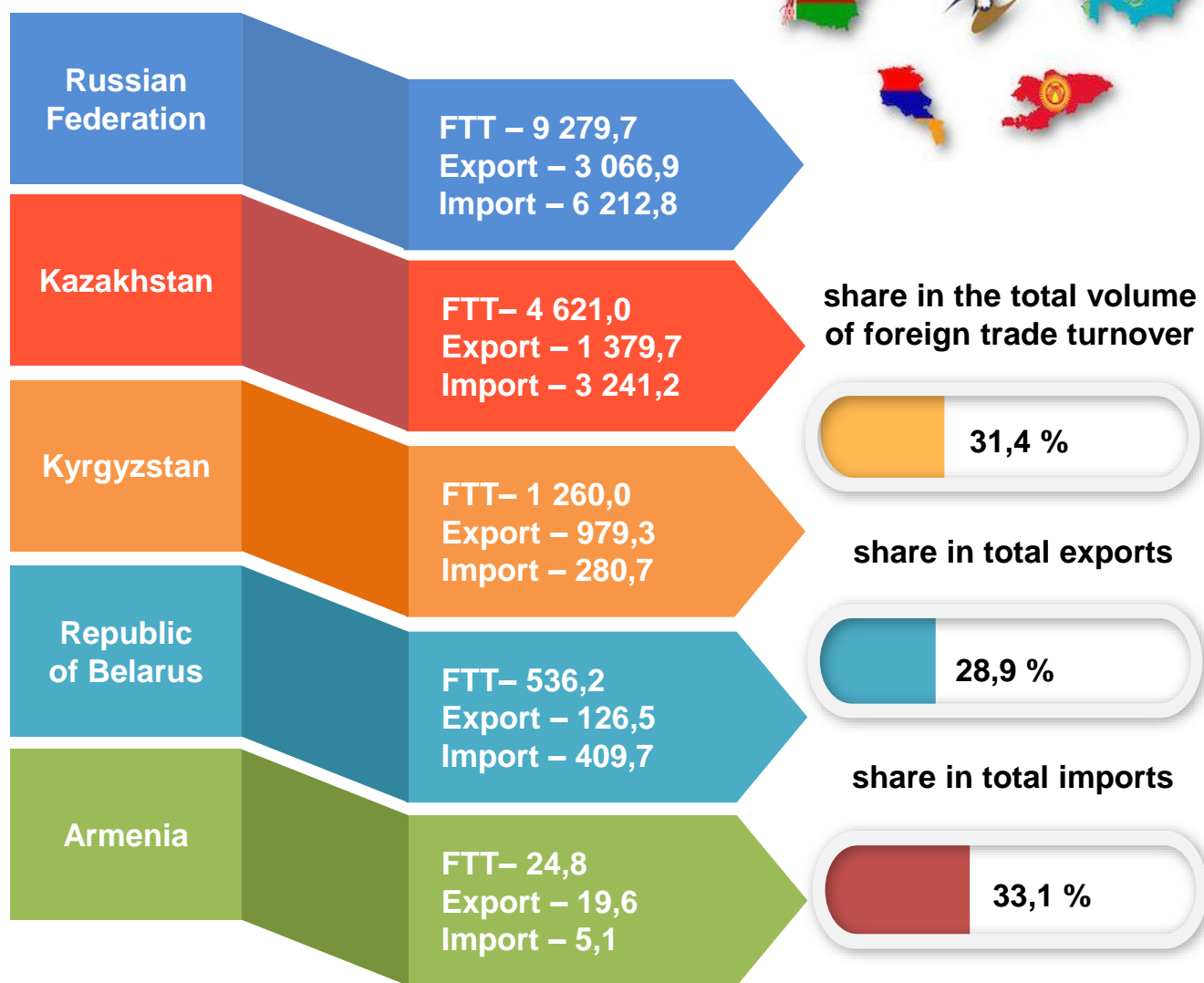

(for January-December 2022)

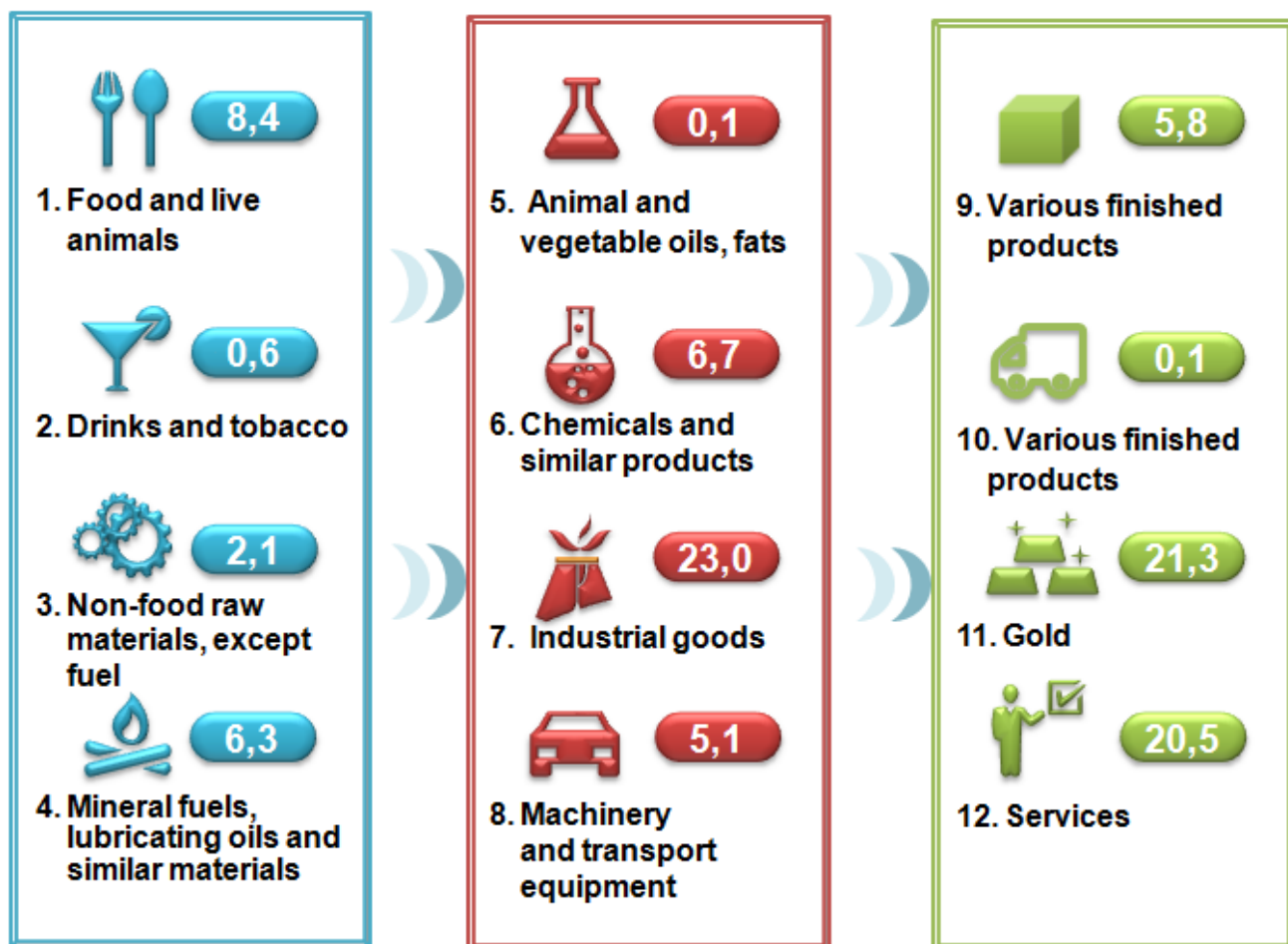


In January-December 2022, the total number of exporting entities amounted to **7 199** units, which ensured that the volume of exports without gold reached **15 198.8** million US dollars (an increase of **121.1%** compared to the same period in 2021).

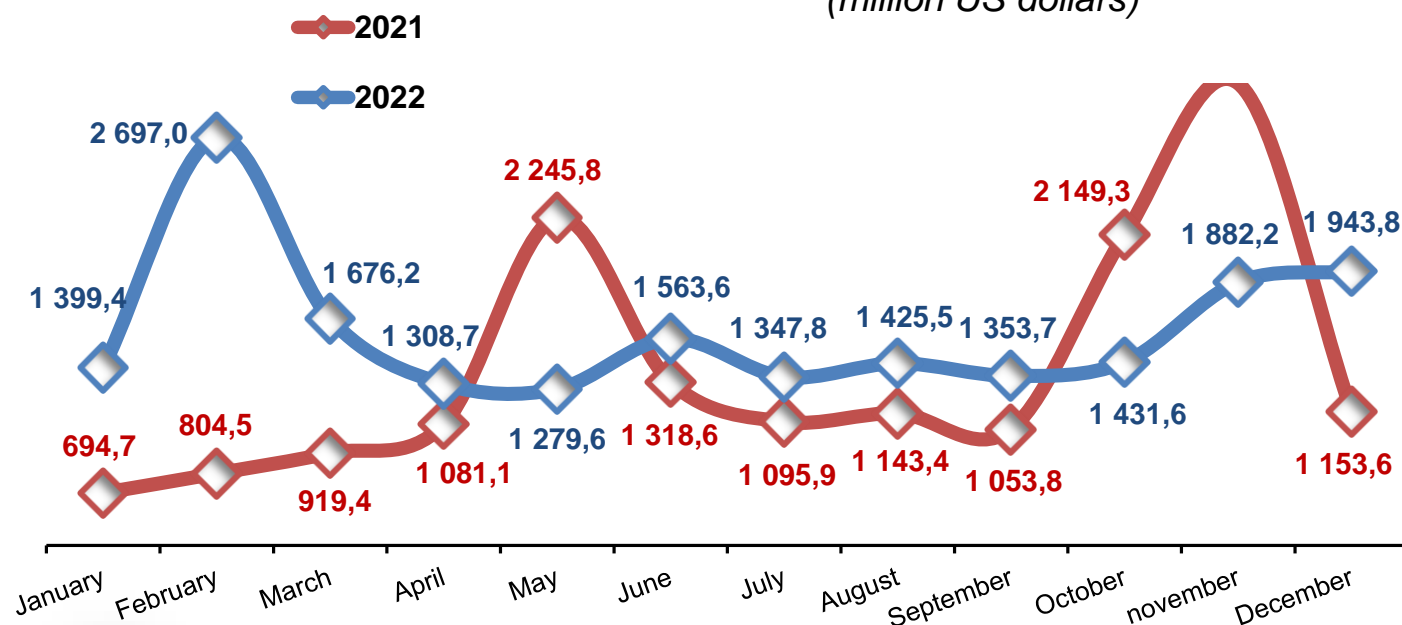

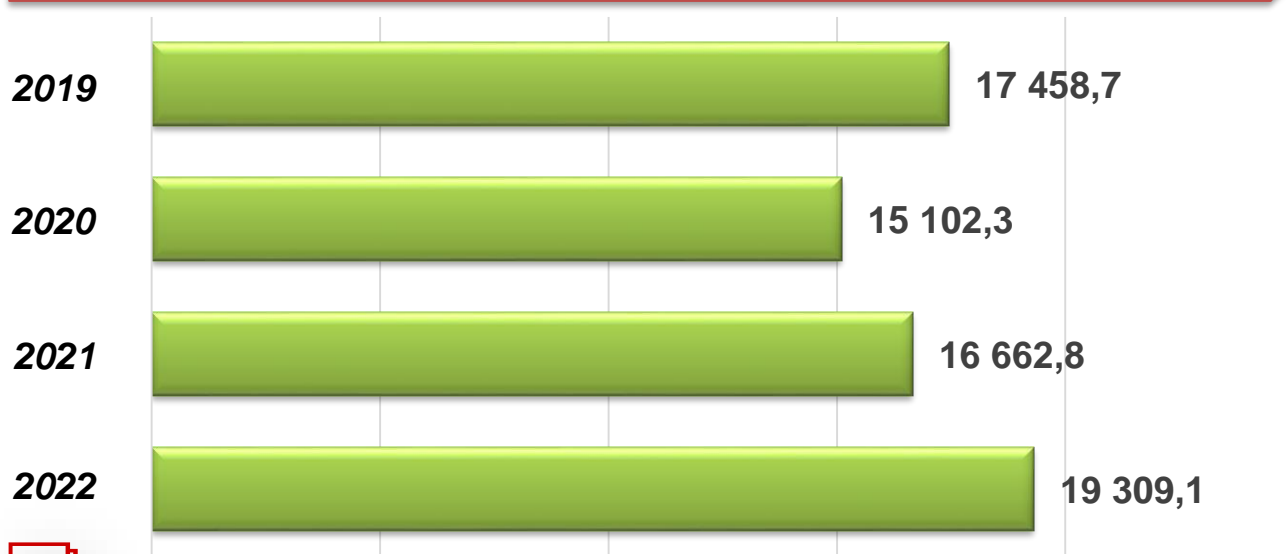


## MONTHLY EXPORT DYNAMICS OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (million US dollars)



The largest volume of exports was recorded in February 2022 and was noted at the level of **2 697.0** million US dollars. Compared to the same month in 2021, its increase amounted to **1 892.6** million US dollars. In December 2022, the volume of exports amounted to **1 943.8** million US dollars and, compared to the same period in 2021, increased by **68.5%**.

Export of Uzbekistan in January-December 2022 amounted to **19 309.1** million US dollars, which is **10.6%** more than in the same period of 2019.

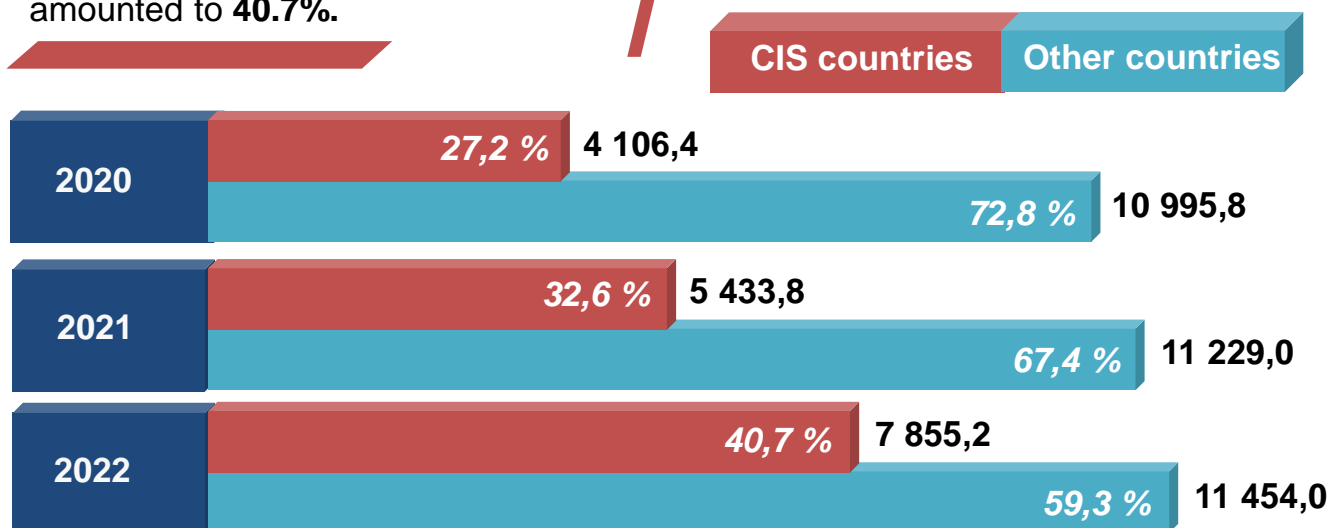

## EXPORT DYNAMICS TO CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES

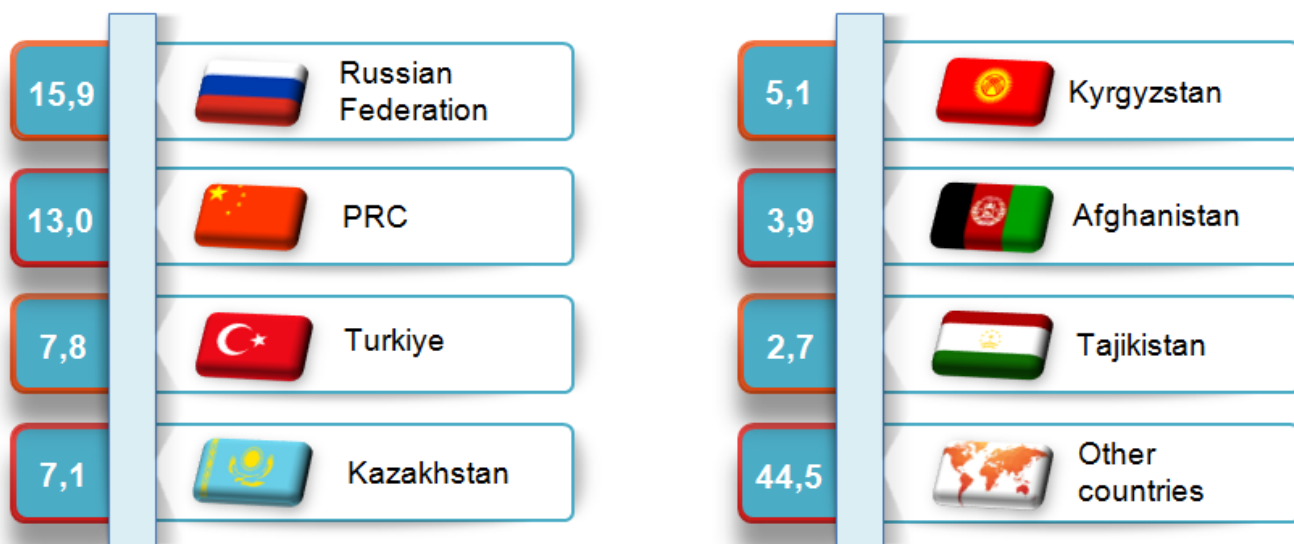

In the structure of exports of the republic, a significant share was noted in Tashkent, which is **23.9%**, or **4 616.9** million US dollars, and the smallest share was recorded at **1.0%**, or **199.5** million US dollars in Jizzakh region.

## EXPORT OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PRODUCTS (for January-December 2022)



In January-December 2022, the share of fruits and vegetables in total exports amounted to **5.9%**.

The main export markets for fruits and vegetables are the Russian Federation, Kazakhstan, China and Pakistan.

The volume of exports of fruits and vegetables in the period under review amounted to **1 743.7** thousand tons and, in value terms, reached **1 145.8** million US dollars (the growth rate, compared to the same period in 2021, amounted to **18.5%**, respectively).

According to the results of January-December 2022, the largest volume in terms of value of exports of fruits and vegetables falls on the Russian Federation (42.5% of the total volume of fruits and vegetables), which exceeds the volume of exports to Kazakhstan by 2.3 times.

According to the results of January-December 2022, the export of textile products was carried out in the amount of **3 178.0** million US dollars, which amounted to **16.5%** of the total export volume and, compared to January-December 2021, it increased by **8.6%**.

In the structure of exports of textile products, the main share is occupied by cotton yarn (**44.4%**), as well as finished knitwear and garments (**29.2%**). In January-December 2022, **552** types of textile products were exported to **73** countries of the world.

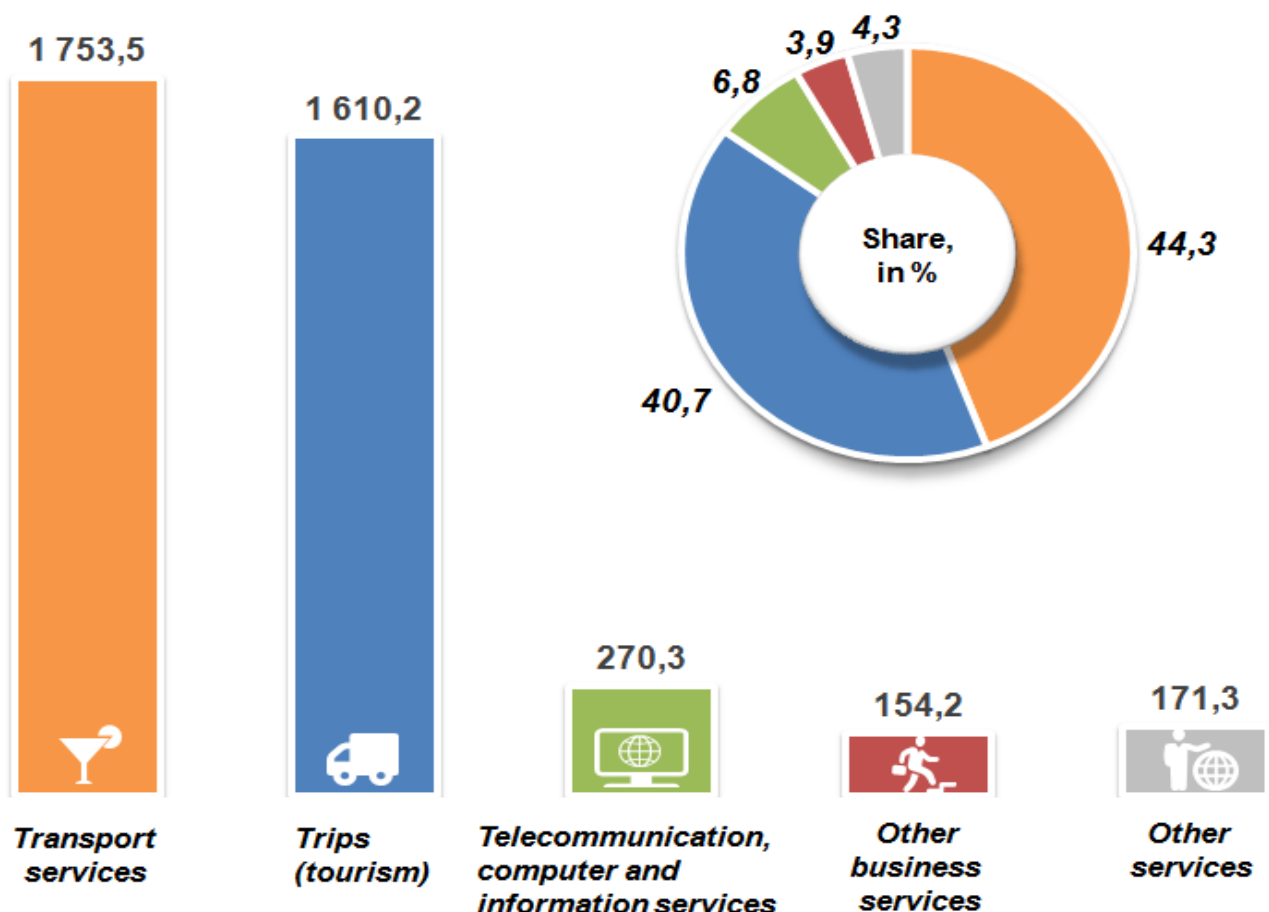


The largest share of textile exports goes to the Russian Federation (1 264.9 million US dollars- 39.8%) and Türkiye (519.1 million US dollars - 16.3%).

The volume of exports of services in January-December 2022 amounted to **3 959.5** million US dollars, or **20.5%** of the total volume of trade exports and increased by **53.4%** compared to the same period in 2021. As part of the export of services, the lion's share is occupied by transport services (**44.3%**), travel (tourism) (**40.7%**), telecommunications, computer and information services (**6.8%**), other business services (**3.9%**).



At the same time, for other services (**4.3%**), the largest share, respectively, falls on financial services (**1.8%**), insurance and pension services (**1.4%**), maintenance and repair services (**0.4%**) and etc.





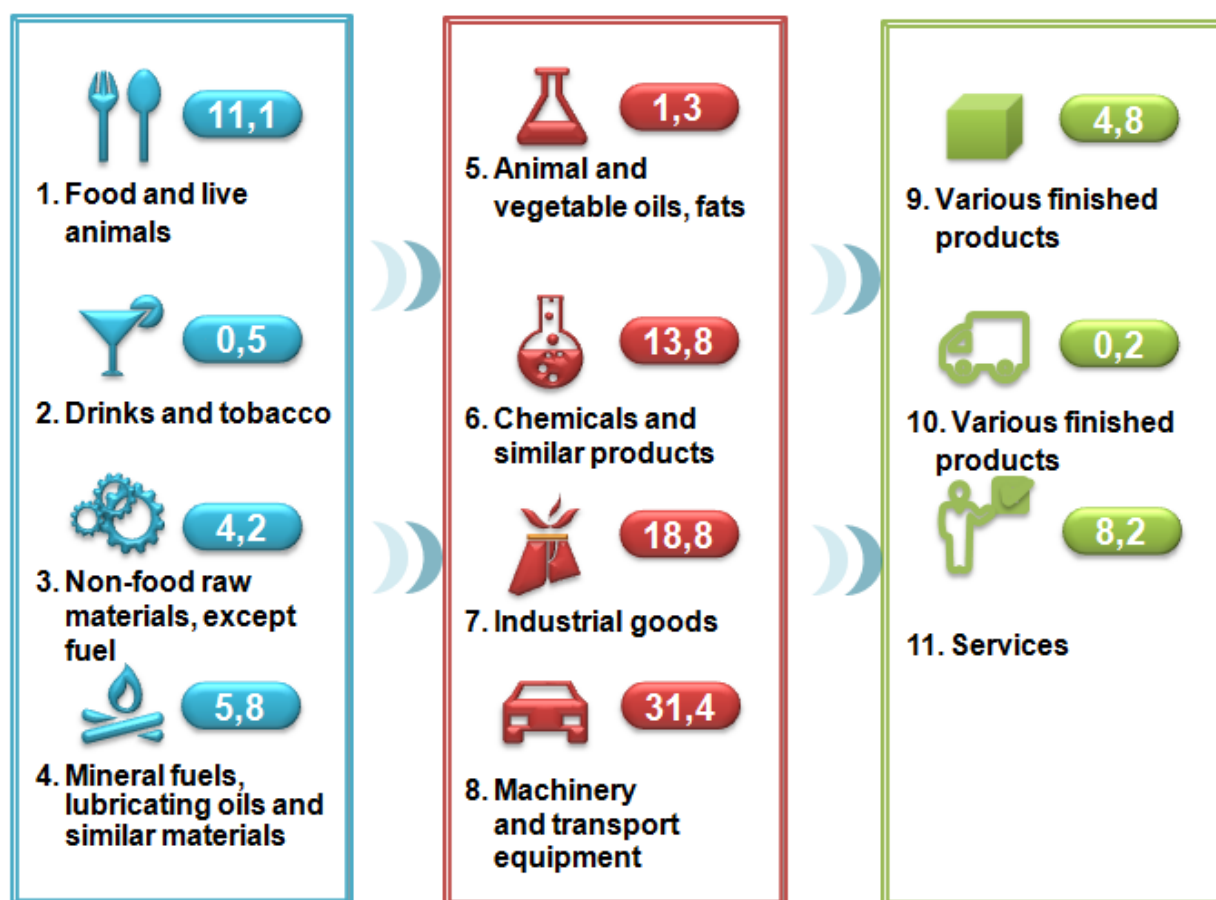


## IMPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-December 2022)

During the reporting period, imports amounted to **30 699.3** million US dollars (an increase in growth rates, compared to January-December 2021, amounted to **120.4%**). The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (**31.4%**), industrial goods (**18.8%**), as well as chemicals and similar products (**13.8%**).

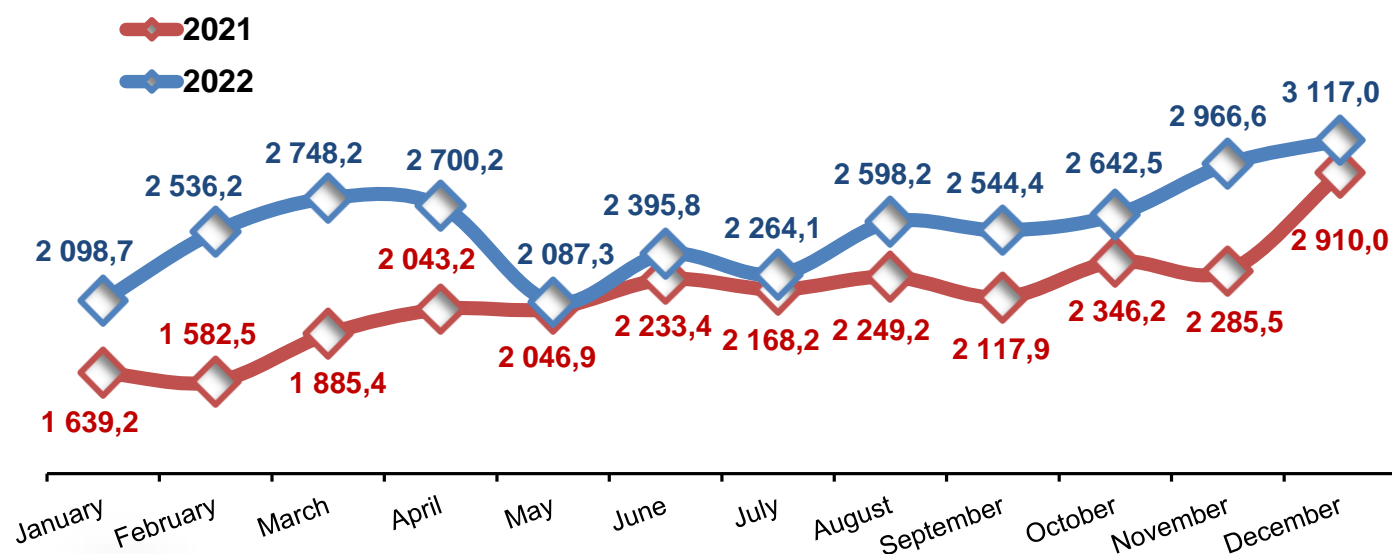

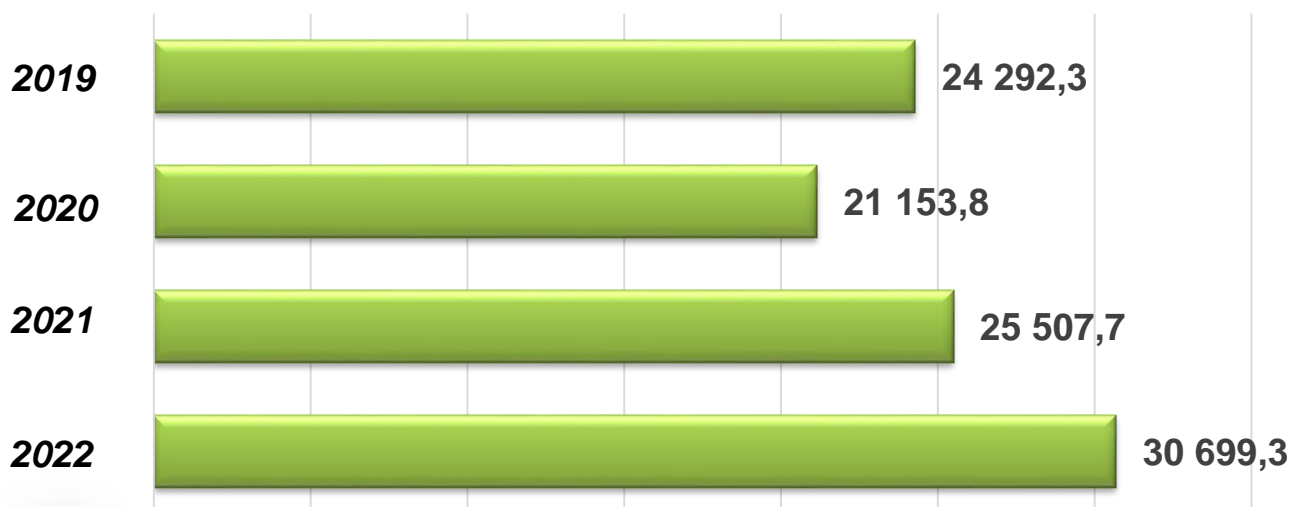


## MONTHLY DYNAMICS OF IMPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (million US dollars)

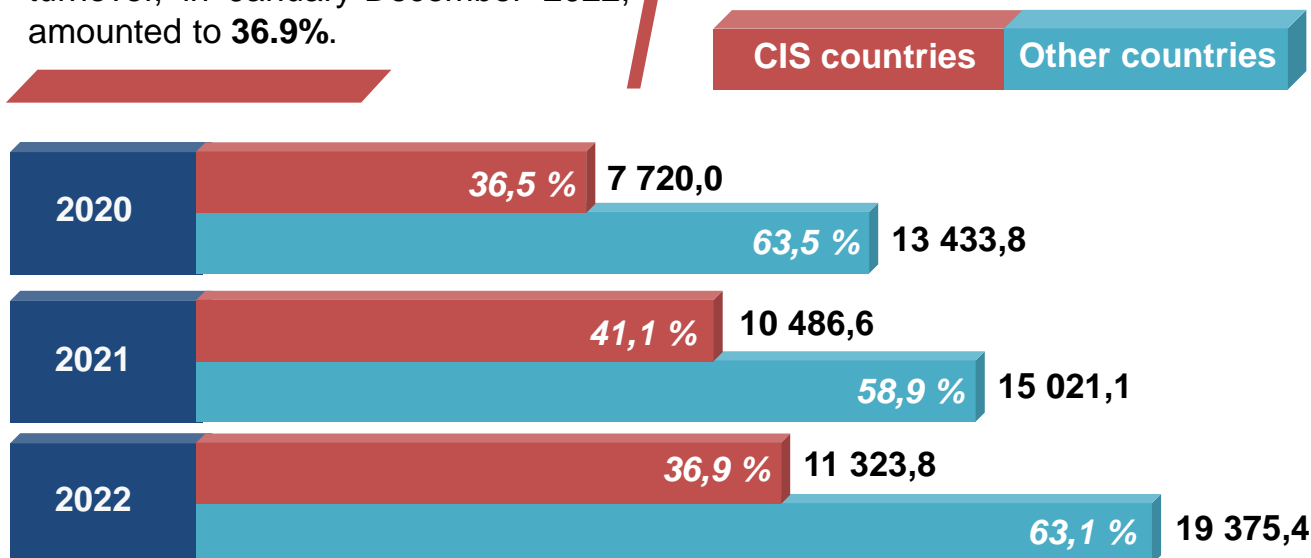

million US dollars, share, %)

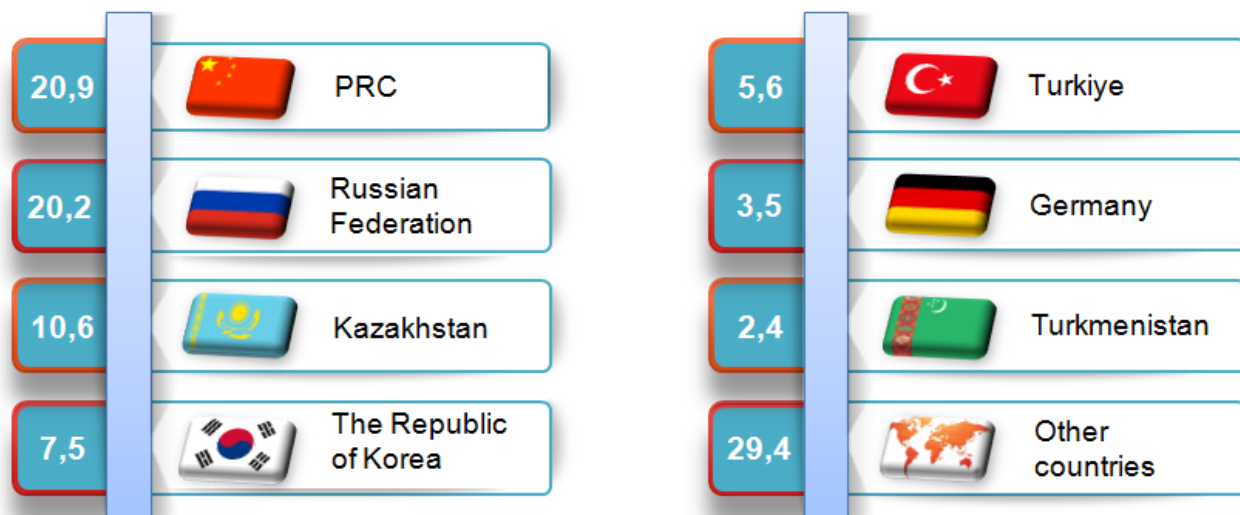

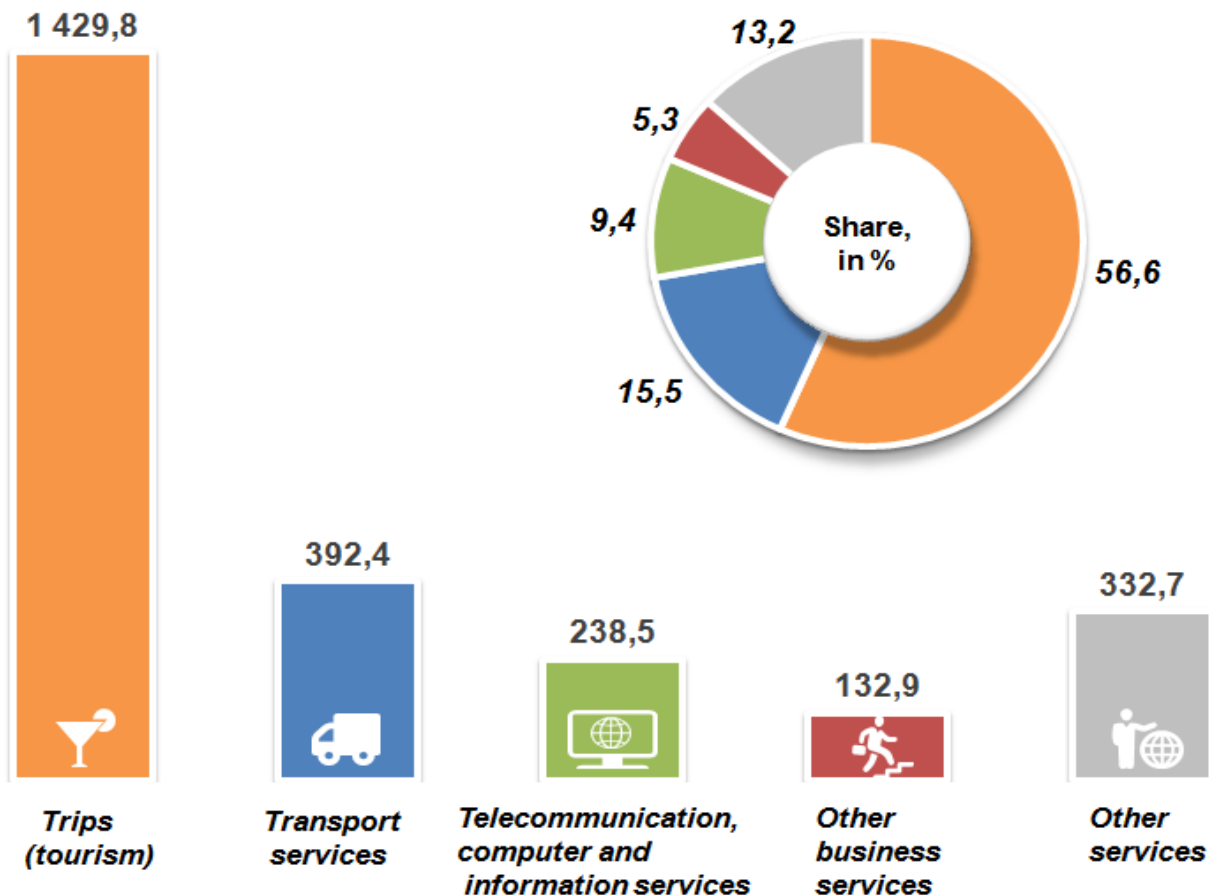

In the structure of imports of the republic, a significant share was noted in Tashkent city, which is **48.6%**, or **14 913.2** million US dollars, and the smallest share was recorded in Surkhandarya - **0.5%**, or **145.2** million US dollars.

The volume of imports of services in January-December 2022 amounted to **2 526.3** million US dollars, or **8.2%** of its total volume, and increased by **42.9%** compared to the same period in 2021. As part of the import of services, the main share is occupied by travel (tourism - **56.6%**), transport services (**15.5%**), telecommunications, computer and information services (**9.4%**), other business services (**5.3%**).

## IMPORT OF MACHINERY AND TRANSPORT EQUIPMENT

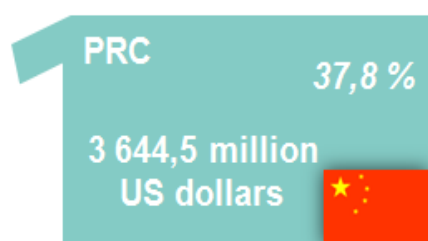

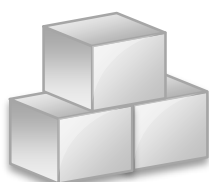

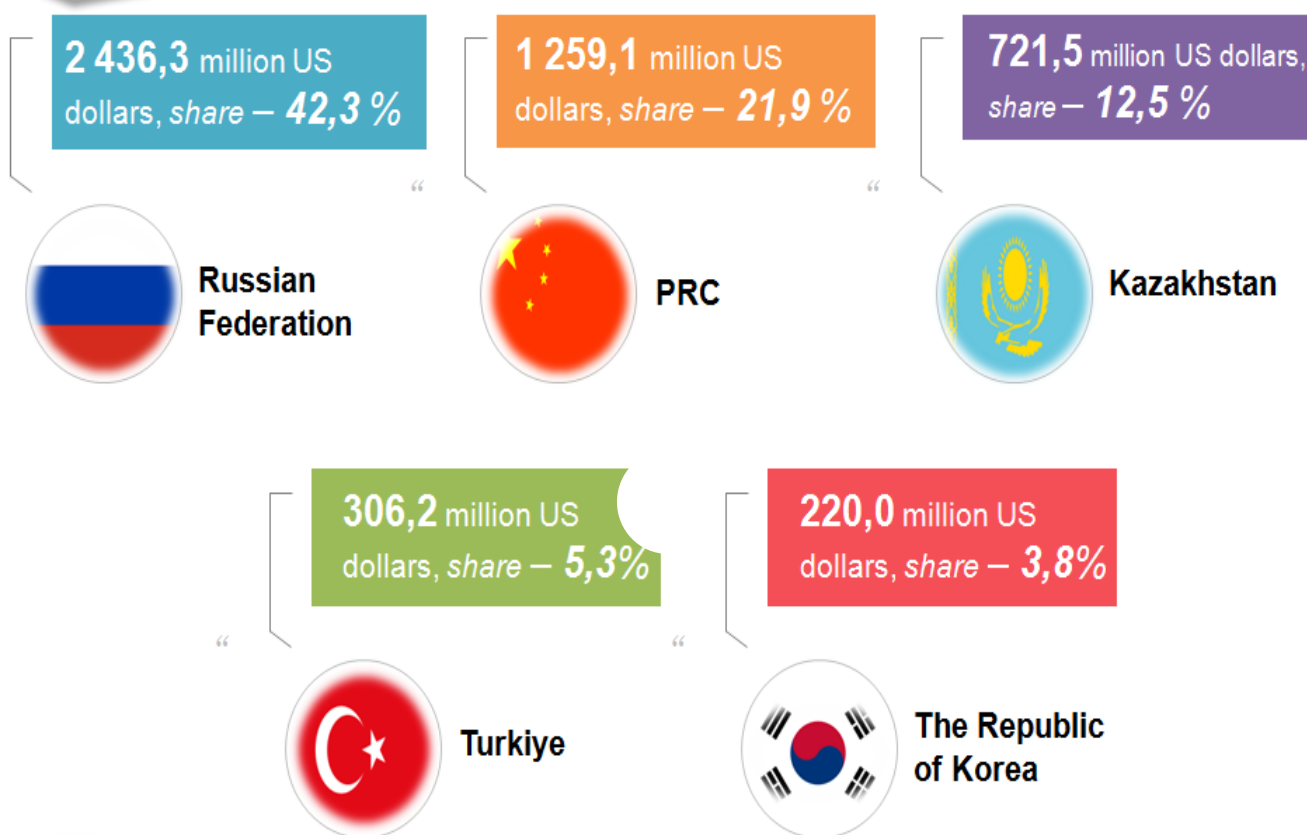
